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Call for Papers

YORÙBÁ – The journal of the Yoruba Studies Association of Nigeria is published twice a year: January and June. Articles are requested from members and all interested academics, researchers and scholars in any area of Yoruba studies and associated disciplines. The articles which may be qualitative or quantitative in nature must be original.

Guidelines for authors

1. Each article should be typed double-spaced in Times New Roman and should not exceed 15 pages of A4 paper in font size 12 including the cover page and references.
2. All tables, figures, charts, diagrams and illustrations should be inserted and logically presented within maximum of 15 pages A4 paper.
3. The article should be preceded by an abstract that should not exceed 250 words.
4. At the end of the abstract, **five keys words (maximum)** emanating from the paper should be listed.
5. Format: Font of body text should be Times New Roman Size 12. Alignment should be justified. Paragraphs should be indented with one tab (no block paragraphing). Line spacing should be 1.5 lines.
6. The cover page should include: title of the article, author(s)' name(s), address(es), phone number(s) and e-mail address(es). Surname should be written first and in capital letters before other names.
7. Manuscript(s) should be sent as MS word attachment to: akangbeclem@gmail.com. Articles that are

submitted for publication in *YORÙBÁ* should not have been submitted in another journal.

8. Articles that are submitted must be accompanied with a non-refundable sum of six thousand naira (₦6, 000) assessment fee. A publication fee of ₦15, 000 will be paid upon a successful assessment of the paper.
9. Referencing should follow the American Psychological Association (APA) style and all references should be listed, in strict alphabetical order, at the end of the article.

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
